### Follow-Up Questions

For QA 106

**According to answer 106, where does sin begin?**

Sin always begins in the mind, within the thoughts. You are what you think!

For QA 107

**How is the positive dimension of the sixth commandment so different from how people typically act toward their neighbor in our time?"**

Typically, people today don't want to know their neighbors or have anything to do with them. Also, we don't naturally think about how to promote their good.

For QA 108

**Does the seventh commandment just speak of the sin of adultery?**

No, it speaks of every kind of sexual sin whether we are married or not.

For QA 109

Think about the ways in which our bodies are involved in sexual sin – our eyes, ears, mouths (“unchaste words”) and brains (“thoughts”). It is helpful to think about ways in which to keep ourselves away from tempting situations.

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**Memorizing vs. reading:** parents, if you think your child is too young to memorize the catechism, you can read it aloud to them following the reading schedule above. Everyone else of all ages should try to memorize the catechism following the memorization schedule above.

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
