Date	If you're memorizing...	If you're just reading...
November 6	Discuss QA 24, memorize for next Sunday	Read Lord's Day 22 (QA 57,58)
November 13	Discuss QA 25, memorize for next Sunday	Read Lord's Day 23 (QA 59-61)
November 20	Discuss QA 26, memorize for next Sunday	Read Lord's Day 24 (QA 62-64)
November 27	Review QA 26, memorize for next Sunday	Read Lord's Day 25 (QA 65-68)
October 30	Review QA 24-26	Read Lord's Day 26 (QA 69-71)

Parents: For each date listed above, we will first have the kids recite the answer they memorized from the previous Sunday. Then, we will discuss the substance of the next question and answer from the Catechism for which the kids will be responsible to memorize for the next week. For example, for Sunday the 13th, the kids will need to have memorized question and answer 24 from the Catechism. Once they recite the answer, we will spend the rest of the class discussing the meaning of question and answer 25. For families with very young children who are learning the "Tiny Tots" catechism, they can follow the reading schedule for family worship. Adults too, are encouraged to memorize or at least read through the Catechism.

Memorizing vs. reading: parents, if you think your child is too young to memorize the catechism, you can read it aloud to them following the reading schedule above. Everyone else of all ages should try to memorize the catechism following the memorization schedule above.
