

## High Desert URC · Heidelberg Catechism Schedule September 2023

Date	If you're memorizing...	If you're just reading...
September 3	Discuss <a href="#">QA 56</a> , memorize for next Sunday	Read <a href="#">Lord's Day 9</a> (QA 26)
September 10	Discuss <a href="#">QA 57</a> , memorize for next Sunday	Read <a href="#">Lord's Day 10</a> (QA 27-28)
September 17	Discuss <a href="#">QA 58</a> , memorize for next Sunday	Read <a href="#">Lord's Day 11</a> (QA 29-30)
September 24	Review QA 56-58	Read <a href="#">Lord's Day 12</a> (QA 31-32)

Parents: For each date listed above, we will first have the kids recite the answer they memorized from the previous Sunday. Then, we will discuss the substance of the next question and answer from the Catechism for which the kids will be responsible to memorize for the next week. For example, for Sunday the 10<sup>th</sup>, the kids will need to have memorized question and answer 56 from the Catechism. Once they recite the answer, we will spend the rest of the class discussing the meaning of question and answer 57. For families with very young children who are learning the “Tiny Tots” catechism, they can follow the reading schedule for family worship. Adults too, are encouraged to memorize or at least read through the Catechism.

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**Memorizing vs. reading:** parents, if you think your child is too young to memorize the catechism, you can read it aloud to them following the reading schedule above. Everyone else of all ages should try to memorize the catechism following the memorization schedule above.
